Y-PREP offers case management services both on an individual level as well as in groups (if applicable). Services are individualized based on the needs of each youth.

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Young Parent Resource & Empowerment Program (Y-PREP)

A program serving young pregnant and/or parenting youth (males and females).





Eligibility

Primary Eligibility Requirements

- Pregnant and/or Parenting
- 14-21 years old (Male or Female)
- Currently in foster care (not required), in the process of leaving foster care, history of foster care, or at risk of foster care placement.

Y-PREP is also suited to help youth in the following situations:

- At risk of homelessness
- Poor school attendance/performance or at risk of dropping out of school
- Youth involved in the juvenile justice system and/or child protective services
- History of disruptive behaviors

Services

Each youth in the Y-PREP program is provided with the following:

- One-on-one meetings
- Group sessions
- Training groups
- Experiential learning to improve their skill set

Focus Areas Include:

- Education/Vocation
- Parenting skill development
- Prenatal care/birth support
- Coping skills
- Healthy Relationships
- Career Exploration, Job Placement and Retention
- Daily Living Skills
- Mental, Physical, Emotional, and Behavioral Health
- Housing



Services Continued

Ongoing crisis management will be provided through an on-call system as well as appropriate clinical services to meet the youth's needs. Y-PREP is focused on a team approach geared towards developing a partnership with the youth and involved family members who will provide support, guidance and training on an individual basis. Each youth will work with the Y-PREP Case Planner and Independent Living Trainer.
